About Study China

The Study China Programme is managed by The University of Manchester and funded by the Department for Business, Energy & Industrial Strategy.

Study China will not be confined to classroom learning. A curriculum of work-shops, trips and excursions you will introduce you to the real China.

Do I need to be able to speak Chinese Mandarin?

No, we welcome applications from students with any level of language experience, from absolute beginners to fluent speakers. You will be placed in a tiered class depending on your ability and experience.

What will it cost?

The UK government generously fund the vast majority of all associated costs, including tuition fees, accommodation, organised trips and excursions.

You will need to only fund your airfare and spending money.

Funding contributions for airfare and spending money

Study China has been running since 2007 and is recognised by many universities as an essential study abroad programme, therefore you may be able to successfully apply for funding from your university to support airfare and spending money. The Study China team can assist you in doing so.
